Loup Bleu is the new label for our house rosé and the pedigree could not be better. Coming from the Cotes de Provence the wines has the pale elegance and finesse one would expect from these classic vineyards.

A lovely, vibrant nose of un-oaked blueberry fruit, plum and a touch of spice with rich, juicy fruit on the palate.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA (13%)

Expressive nose of blackberry and coffee with finely balanced, fuller bodied palate tannins and a spicy black fruit finish.

**MANOIR DU CARRA BEAUJOLAIS-VILLAGES 2014****£6.00**

BOURGOGNE, FRANCE (12.5%) O

A delicious Beaujolais-Village typifying the new wave of wines now flowing from this region; fresh fruit forward with real style and finesse. This is organically produced and unfiltered.

## Prosecco and English Sparkling Wine

### **VIGNAROSA PROSECCO NV**

VENETO, ITALY (12%)

BIN 1

**£28**

Made by a family run estate in the hills above Treviso in the Veneto from the Prosecco grape, this now popular sparkling wine has a very fine mousse and displays green apple flavours with a little twist of fruit on the finish.

### **HAMBLEDON BRUT N.V.**

HAMBLEDON, HAMPSHIRE (12%)

BIN 2

**£44**

Produced at what is considered England's oldest sparkling wine vineyard on planted on pure chalk from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Hambledon has had serious reinvestment over the past decade and is now on terms with some of the finest sparkling wine producers in the world. This is a finely tuned, racy pure wine with great length and complexity.

### **HATTINGLY VALLEY, BRUT 2013**

ALRESFORD, HAMPSHIRE (12%)

BIN 3

**£44**

Produced from a single plot of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grown on a south facing, idyllic greenstone rich vineyard. Nose is laced with complex brioche summer fruit and citrus, the palate mouth-watering and well integrated.

### **COATES AND SEELY, BRUT RESERVE, NV**

WHITCHURCH, HAMPSHIRE, (12%)

BIN 4

**£44**

A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, this is light, very elegant and fragile. The aromas are of white currant, white flower blossom fresh pear. The palate is at first lively, quickly settling into a creamy mousse with a perfect balance between racy fruit and soft elegance. It is long and vital to the finish.

### **COATES AND SEELY, BRUT ROSÉ NV**

WHITCHURCH, HAMPSHIRE, (12%)

BIN 5

**£44**

Very fine, lucid, pink heralds the subtle, but precise aromas of red cherry blossom, red currant and white pear. The palate is a little richer than the Brut Reserve, with more red fruit and a flash of refreshing acidity on the finish.

## C h a m p a g n e

**CAMILLE SAVÈS CARTE BLANCHE 1<sup>re</sup> CRU CHAMPAGNE NV** 37.5cl **£23**  
 FRANCE (12%) LR BIN 6 75cl **£44**

From a small, family owned estate in the Grand Cru village of Bouzy. 75% Pinot Noir with a high proportion of older reserve wines used in the blend, the Carte Blanche is both rich and biscuity, yet with a lovely, refreshing acidity.

**CAMILLE SAVES CUVÉE BRUT ROSÉ BOUZY GRAND CRU NV**  
 FRANCE (12%) LR BIN 7 **£52**

A blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Bouzy Rouge, the famous red wine made from Pinot grapes on the south facing vineyards above the village of Bouzy. Ripe, but delicate with lovely aromas of rose petals and fresh strawberries.

**CAMILLE SAVES CUVÉE BRUT BOUZY GRAND CRU 2009**  
 FRANCE (12%) LR BIN 8 **£65**

A wine made with lavish attention in the vineyard and cellar, with partial oak ageing of the ‘vin clair’ and extended time on bottle on the lees. This gives a rich, complex character which allies well with the depth of this stunning vintage

**BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE NV**  
 FRANCE (12.5%) LR BIN 9 **£80**

Bollinger is renowned for rich, opulent Champagne that embodies the very best that this region can produce. Notes of hazelnut, honey and biscuit overlay hints of red summer fruits.

**JOSEPH PERRIER CUVÉE ROYALE, 2004**  
 FRANCE (12.5%) LR BIN 11 **£85**

Joseph Perrier are one of the smallest of the ‘Grande Marque’ and still retain the integrity and style that attracted Queen Victoria to their wines. This is from the fabulous 2004 vintage and exudes the richness, brioche notes and wonderfully complex palate one would expect from such a fine producer.

**BILLECART SALMON ROSÉ, BRUT NV**  
 FRANCE (12.5%) LR BIN 10 **£90**

A classic wine in every sense and this has rightly become an icon of rosé wine the world over. Red fruit, a creamy mousse and a long, beautifully tapered finish demonstrate why.

## Sherries

<b>BODEGAS FERNANDO CLASSIC FINO</b>	70ml Glass	<b>£5</b>

The cellars of Bodegas Rey Fernando de Castilla are located in the historic centre of Jerez. Bone dry, with a beautiful blend of citrus and stone fruit flavours and a wonderfully nutty finish.

<b>HEREDEROS DE ARGUESO LAS MEDALLAS MANZANILLA</b>		
SANLUCAR DE BARRAMEDA, SPAIN (15%)	37.5cl	<b>£18</b>

Wonderfully bone dry, crisp, tangy and yeasty, with touches of sea salt from the proximity of the vineyards to the coast. Not as rich as the Fino, this really is the perfect apéritif.

<b>BODEGAS HIDALGO WELLINGTON CORTADO</b>		
JEREZ, SPAIN (18%)	50cl	<b>£65</b>

The amazing thing about these old sherries is that the winery actually needs to schedule an appointment with the Consejo to unlock the barrels to bottle it! A round, plush mouthfeel of toasted nuts and caramel are enlivened by a saline note that makes this dry sherry a real treat.

<b>BODEGAS FERNANDO ANTIQUE AMONTILLADO</b>	70ml Glass	<b>£6.60</b>
JEREZ, SPAIN (18%)	75cl	<b>£45</b>

Glorious aromas of dried figs, cloves and orange peel, leading to a wonderfully velvety Amontillado. The Antique is just off-dry, with a hint of salty ranchio character, finishing with a very long, nutty finish that lingers and evolves for an age.

<b>BODEGAS FERNANDO 'PX' ANTIQUE</b>	70ml Glass	<b>£7.60</b>
JEREZ, SPAIN (20%)	50cl	<b>£45</b>

PX, or Pedro Ximinez, is the grape variety used to make this unctuous, inky super sweet wine. The long aging process and raisoned grapes create an almost resinous like texture and give flavours of nutty dried fruit, damson and Christmas cake.



## Fresh, Light White Wines

### **EMILIANA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2016**

CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE (13%)

BIN 12

**£22**

An award winning Sauvignon Blanc, this is a perfectly balanced wine, with fresh, bright aromas of greengage and ripe apple and a crisp, mineral finish.

### **MIRABELLO PINOT GRIGIO 2015**

VENETO, ITALY (12%)

BIN 13

**£24**

From cool hillsides in Veneto, this attractive Pinot Grigio has a delicate floral and fruity bouquet. A soft, easy, dry wine that will match with a wide range of lighter dishes.

### **DOMAINE FAY D'HOMME MUSCADET SUR LIE 2015**

LOIRE, FRANCE (12.5%) **O**

BIN 14

**£27**

Vincent Caillé, of Fay d'Homme, is one of the leading lights of the resurgence in fine quality Muscadet, a region so often overlooked by wine lovers. The mineral freshness, fruit expression and refined palate make for delicious drinking with or without food.

### **LOXAREL CORA 2015**

PENEDES, SPAIN (11.5%) **B**

BIN 15

**£29**

Cora is a delicious blend of Xarello and Muscat, unusual in its name, but the flavours will be so familiar. Notes of lime, fresh satsuma and gooseberry are allied to a palate of fresh citrus fruits and a touch of softer white fruit

### **LAWSON'S DRY HILLS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2015**

MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND (13 %) **LR**

BIN 16

**£35**

Lawson's is a family owned estate that has undergone rigorous upheaval to dramatically improve the quality of their wines. The intensity and varietal character of this wine is so typical of the region, but with added depth and complexity giving the wine real bite.

### **PATRICK PIUZE TERROIR DE FYE CHABLIS 2015**

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (12.0%) **O**

BIN 17

**£38**

Fast becoming one of the stars of Burgundy, Patrick produces terroir driven wines from this classic region. Fye is located next to the 1er Cru of Montée de Tonnerre just south of the Grand Cru. It has nutty, citrus qualities with great depth and natural finesse.

## Fuller Bodied White Wines

### **ADI BADENHORST SECATEURS CHENIN BLANC 2015**

SWARTLAND, SOUTH AFRICA (14.5%) **O**

BIN 18

**£28**

Adi is one of the great new wave producers in South Africa, he is committed to producing terroir driven, organic wines in some of the most beautiful vineyards in the cape. This wine is full of apple, honeyed aromas and a rich, dry palate packed with flavour.

### **ZACCAGNINI VERDICCHIO DI JESI 'CIMA SIGNORIA' 2015**

MARCHE, ITALY (13.5%) **LR**

BIN 19

**£32**

Verdicchio is one of Italy's great cornerstone varieties, likened to an aromatic Chardonnay. Here in Jesi, and in the hands of the historic Zaccagnini Estate, the wines develop a complex nutty character which balances perfectly with the citrus and seaside freshness.

### **TIERRA LABASTIDA CRIANZA BLANCO 2015**

RIOJA, SPAIN (14.0%) **B**

BIN 20

**£39**

Produced in the hills overlooking the plains of Rioja Alta from Viura, Garnacha Blanco and Malvasia. The latter variety gives a distinctive top note to the citrus confit and apricot fruit of the former two varieties. Aged in new American oak for 6-8 months lending an air of sophistication.

### **FORJAS DEL SALNES ALBARIÑO 'LEIRANA' 2015**

RIAS BAIXAS, SPAIN (12.5%) **O**

BIN 21

**£39**

Rodrigo Mendez uses vine that are up to 200 years old to produce one of the most intense and lively Albariño wines. Rodrigo blends cooler vineyards fruit where the acidity is a little higher to lift denser fruit of the old vines, giving a lime character to the honeyed peach fruit.

### **DOMAINE GANDINES VIRÉ-CLESSE 2015**

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (13.5%) **O**

BIN 22

**£42**

The two villages of Viré and Clessé have such character that they were put together to form their own appellation. Ben Dananchet's wines have the classic honey-suckle, white peach and nutty character of the vineyards as well as an extra dimension of zesty mineral fruit.

## Rare and Wonderful White Wines

### **BODEGAS CARBALLAL, EREBO GODELLO 2015**

GALICIA, SPAIN (13%) **LR**

BIN 23

**£28**

Godello is fast becoming the trendy grape of NW Spain. It has delicious pear and bee's wax notes on the nose and mineral, waxy fruit on the palate. This is no exception and the slate soils of Valdeorras give an extra level of complexity.

### **ANCRE HILL CHARDONNAY 2014**

MONMOUTH, WALES (10%) **B**

BIN 24

**£33**

Ancre Hill are located on a hillside above the pretty market town on Monmouth. The vineyards were planted in 2006 and were farmed organically until 2013 and biodynamically since, the first in the UK. This is an intense, elegant wine with clear precision and an edge demanding to be taken seriously. Fermented and aged in oak with no fining or filtration.

### **ESCRIBIENTE, PAGOS DE VILAVENDEMIA 2014**

RUEDA, SPAIN (13.5%) **B**

BIN 25

**£39**

Vidal Soblechero who makes this wine is one of Spain's best loved, but least known wine producer. He works with old vines and makes tiny amounts of detailed and terroir driven wines which are found in most of Spain's finest restaurants. This is a pure, concentrated expression of Verdejo and Viura, refreshing elegant and complex, bucking the trend in a region famous for its more bulk style wines.

### **THOMAS LABAILLE SANCERRE 'MONTS DAMNES' 2015**

LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE (13.5%) **LR**

BIN 26

**£50**

Jean-Paul Labaille is a humble man who has a few hectares on the fabled 'Grand Cru' of Sancerre, Mont Damnes'. The chalk slope impresses the wine with an intense minerality and concentrated herb infused fruit.

### **G. BOUTON PULIGNY MONTRACHET 1<sup>st</sup> CRU 'LA GARENNE', 2015**

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (13%) **LR**

BIN 27

**£75**

Bouton has 8 ha of old vines including a tiny plot in the 1er Cru of Garenne. The vines here are 70 years old, producing a deeply concentrated style allied to typical Puligny lemon tinged acidity. The oak is well honed, framing the wine and the finish is long and sumptuous.

## Aromatic White Wines

### DOMAINE D'UBY DOMUS BLANC 2015

GASCONY, FRANCE (11.5%) **LR**

BIN 28

**£24**

Amazing aromatics of grapefruit, citrus zest and fresh gooseberry lead to a refreshing, vital, and light-bodied palate which both works well both with food, or as an apéritif.

### DOMAINE MITTNACHT GEWURZTRAMINER 2015

ALSACE, FRANCE (12.5%) **B**

BIN 29

**£32**

Gewurztraminer is renowned for the floral, rose petal and Turkish Delight nose and richly spiced palate. This example has all these facets, as well as being exceedingly well balanced and extremely drinkable as an apéritif too.

### KILIKANOON MORTS BLOCK RIESLING 2014

CLARE VALLEY, AUSTRALIA (12.5 %) **LR**

BIN 30

**£35**

This Riesling is produced from three sites within the Watervale sub region of the Clare Valley. The skill here is to balance the knife edge acidity with the intense lime fruit which Kilikanoon do with consummate skill.

## Rosé Wines

### DOMAINE LOUP BLEU 'VOL DE NUTT' ROSÉ 2015

COTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE (12.5 %) **O**

BIN 31

**£24**

Loup Bleu is the new label for our house rosé and the pedigree could not be better. Coming from the Cotes de Provence the wines has the pale elegance and finesse one would expect from these classic vineyards.

### RIMAURESQ CRU CLASSÉ ROSÉ 2015

CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE (13%) **LR**

BIN 32

75cl **£39**

1.5ltr **£80**

3lt **£140**

With its unusually pale colour and dry extended flavours, this rosé exhibits a wealth of Provençal charm. A blend of Cinsault, Tibouren and Grenache from northeast facing vineyards that protect the wines from excessive heat and extend the ripening period.

## Light Bodied Red Wines

### **MONTE TONDO CORVINA 2015**

VENETO ITALY (12.5%) **LR**

BIN 33

**£24**

Essentially a Valpolicella, produced using younger vines of the estates vineyards in San Pietro del Veneto. This gives the wines a lifted, fresh nose and juicy forward fruit, and careful selection and skilled winemaking give the wine balance and elegance too. Delicious slightly chilled.

### **DOMAINE MURET PINOT NOIR 2014**

LANGUEDOC, FRANCE (13%) **LR**

BIN 34

**£26**

Christophe Muret has a deft hand with lighter red grapes in his vineyards around Picpoul. The wine is gently aromatic with nuanced red fruit and spice and framed by a touch of French oak. The palate has silky tannins and a mouth-watering sappy finish.

### **MOUTHES LE BIHAN PIE COLLETTE ROUGE 2014**

COTES DE DURAS, FRANCE (12.5%) **B**

BIN 35

**£29**

Not a fashionable region, but this Merlot is produced by the exception to the rule. It is so breezy and delightful it is hard to imagine it comes from vineyards so close to Bordeaux. No oak, just pure fruit and bright red plum and red fruit on the palate.

### **MANOIR DE CARRA FLEURIE 2015**

BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE (13%) **O**

BIN 36

**£36**

Manoir de Carra is a domaine run by two young sons, one a viticulturist and the other the winemaker. Both are dedicated to organic viticulture, which repays with interest in great vintages like 2014. This is elegant, floral and concentrated Fleurie at its very best.

## Medium Bodied Red Wines

### **EMILIANA MERLOT 2014**

COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE (13%)

BIN 37

**£22**

The dry, sun-drenched climate, combined with cool nighttime temperatures, ensures perfect ripeness and good flavour retention for the Merlot grapes. Soft, plummy flavours combine with gentle tannins, giving a wine that glides easily over the palate.

## Medium Bodied Red Wines (cont.)

### **LA HOJA RIOJA ALAVESA TEMPRANILLO 2015**

RIOJA, SPAIN (13%) **LR**

BIN 38

**£25**

A finely produced, juicy young wine from the producers of Labastida. Blueberry fruit on the nose with a hint of plum and spice, and a deliciously appetising palate of clean pure red and black fruit and supple finish.

### **DOMAINE REMEJEANNE COTES DU RHONE 'UN AIR' 2015**

RHONE FRANCE (12.5%) **B**

BIN 39

**£29**

A blend of Syrah and Grenache grown above Bangols sur Cezes on the western fringed of the region. The altitude of the vineyards gives freshness to the plummy, ripe red fruit and spice characters. Fermented and aged without oak leaving the fruit to shine through.

### **PIETRO BECONCINI MAURLEO 2013**

TUSCANY, ITALY (13%) **LR**

BIN 40

**£36**

A wine with Chianti running through its heart, Maurleo is a blend of classic Sangiovese and the lesser known indigenous Malvasia Nera. It is aged in Hungarian oak vats for 12 months and is the quintessence of Tuscan reserve. It has a perfumed nose and textured, bright red fruit and exotically herbal palate.

### **MAS DEL PERIE 'LES ESCURES' 2015**

CAHORS, FRANCE (13%) **B**

BIN 41

**£38**

Pure Malbec with minerality derived from the limestone soil of the Quercy Plateau. The vineyard of Escures is one of the highest in the region, bringing a cool, velvet smooth palate and vibrant scented fruit. Fabien Jouves is one of the great 'new-wave' producers of the region.

### **PORT PHILLIP PINOT NOIR 'BALANARRING' 2012**

MORNINGTON PENINSULA, AUSTRALIA (13.5) **LR**

BIN 42

**£55**

Described by the winemaker as a Burgundy with Mornington charm, this wine is produced in a very traditional manner, using whole bunch ferments and long ageing in French barrique. The result is refined complex fruit with a solid, firm structure.

## Fuller Bodied Red Wines

### **SOLDIERS BLOCK SHIRAZ 2016**

SOUTH AUSTRALIA (13%)

BIN 43

**£22**

Soldiers Block is the archetypal Aussie Shiraz with notes of coffee and spice and deep red fruit. The wine also has some solid tannins too to bolster the southern richness.

### **NIETO MALBEC 2015**

MENDOZA, ARGENTINA (14.0%) **LR**

BIN 44

**£32**

Nieto are located in the finest vineyards for Malbec, and have etched out a reputation among the names of this region as a producer of excellent, full bodied but balanced wines. This is a brooding example spice laden wine with fully packed fruit and assertive tannins.

### **MASSAYA 'LE COLOMBIER' CLASSIC RED 2013**

BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON (14.5%) **LR**

BIN 45

**£36**

A name change for one of our all-time classics from the foot of Mount Lebanon. This is as alluring, spicy and rich as ever, produced from Cabernet, Syrah and Cinsault and aged in French oak barrique. The wine remains a classic and an amazing achievement given the difficult condition surrounding the vineyards.

### **BODEGA DE SARRIA SEÑORIO DE SARRIA GRAN RESERVA 2009**

NAVARRA, SPAIN (12.5%)

BIN 46

**£39**

Bodega de Sarria lies on a large and beautiful estate in the hills above Puente la Reina. The Gran Reserva is only produced in exceptional vintages and delivers ripe dark plums and leather, tannins aged to perfection and a long gentle finish.

### **YARRA YERING AGINCOURT 2012**

YARRA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA (14.0%) **O**

BIN 47

**£55**

Agincourt is the baby brother to the now iconic Dry Red No1 from Yarra Yering. The wine is produced in the same way, just from younger vines and from Cabernet and Merlot only. It has all the hall marks of Dr Carrodus's touch, European restraint using the Yarra Valley palate of colours. It exudes charm and authentic sophistication.

## Rare and Wonderful Red Wines

### **MIETTE SHIRAZ 2013**

BAROSSA AUSTRALIA (14%) **LR**

BIN 48

**£34**

A full bodied version of this famous variety from one of the iconic vineyards of the Barossa. The fruit is hand harvested and fermented in old wooden vats before ageing in oak. The fruit is balanced by fresh acidity and complex dark fruit and spice.

### **VINA LEYDA LES BRISAS PINOT NOIR 2014**

LEYDA VALLEY CHILE (13%) **LR**

BIN 49

**£36**

Leyda have pioneered parcel section Pinot Noir in the Leyda Valley for almost 20 years and were the founders of the Leyda DO. The quality of their wine is due to meticulous care in the vineyard and the proximity of the Pacific, making this great Pinot country. Brisas is Pinot-scented as well as being compact and well structured.

### **GAYLORD MACHON 'GHANY' CROZES HERMITAGE 2014**

RHONE, FRANCE (12.5%) **O**

BIN 50

**£42**

Gaylord is a young producer working with David Reynaud at Les Bruyeres. This is his first vintage under his own name, and the wines are as pure, vibrant and exciting those of his mentor. The syrah is grown on the Haut Chassis fermented in concrete and finished in old 600 litre barrels, giving a finesse and elegance rarely seen in this region.

### **LA SOULA ROUGE 2011**

ROUSSILLON FRANCE (13.5%) **B**

BIN 51

**£55**

La Soula, set up by Gerard Gauby and wine merchants Mark Walford and Roy Richards, was at the very vanguard of the revival of the Roussillon region. Grown on schist and slate soils that mark the region, this display pure, energised fruit due in part also to the biodynamic method of viticulture.
