The very local and award winning Sparkling Wine grown and produced in Whitchurch along the same lines as the finest Champagne. This is a fresh, summer fruit infused, super elegant wine.

### White Wines

A traditional blend from a family run estate in the northern region of Rueda. Fresh, well defined yellow fruit and floral scents on the nose, clean and crisp on the palate.

An award winning Sauvignon Blanc, this is a perfectly balanced wine, with fresh, bright aromas of greengage and ripe apple and a crisp, mineral finish.

**MANOIR DU CARRA BOURGOGNE BLANC 2017**

A wonderfully crisp, appetising white from which has a touch of ripe peach fruit and texture on the palate as a result of the Southern Burgundian climate. The vineyards are tended without chemical products and the winemaking is hands off to allow the terroir to express itself.

Francois Delhon produced this Provence style rose to supply the local bistros in his native Puissalicon and to keep the wines of his more famous neighbour out. What he has made is a stylish and detailed rose with fresh delicate red fruit and a touch of herbs.

An organic Cabernet Sauvignon based blend which exudes cassis and spice fruit character with a juicy, rich palate.

### SOLDIERS BLOCK SHIRAZ 2018

SOUTH AUSTRALIA (13%)

Expressive nose of blackberry and coffee with finely balanced, fuller bodied palate tannins and a spicy black fruit finish.

### MANOIR DU CARRA BEAUJOLAIS-VILLAGES 2016

BOURGOGNE, FRANCE (12.5%) O

A delicious Beaujolais-Village typifying the new wave of wines now flowing from this region; fresh fruit forward with real style and finesse. This is organically produced and unfiltered.

## Prosecco and U.K. Sparkling Wine

### **VIGNAROSA PROSECCO NV**

VENETO, ITALY (12%)

Made by a family run estate in the hills above Treviso in the Veneto from the Prosecco grape, this now popular sparkling wine has a very fine mousse and displays green apple flavours with a little twist of fruit on the finish.

### **HAMBLEDON BRUT N.V.**

HAMBLEDON, HAMPSHIRE (12%)

BIN 2

**£55**

Produced at what is considered England's oldest sparkling wine vineyard on planted on pure chalk from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Hambledon has had serious reinvestment over the past decade and is now on terms with some of the finest sparkling wine producers in the world. This is a finely tuned, racy pure wine with great length and complexity.

### **ANCRE HILL BLANC DES NOIRS, NV**

MONMOUTHSHIRE, WALES (11%) B

BIN 3

**£55**

Ancre Hill is the UK's first fully certified Biodynamic estate and overseen by the meticulous Morris family. This cuvee is a blend of their 2013 and '14 Pinot Noir which is fermented and aged in concrete eggs and 600 litre barrels. It is aged in bottle for 36 month and only 3200 bottles were produced.

### **COATES AND SEELY, BRUT RESERVE, NV**

WHITCHURCH, HAMPSHIRE, (12%)

BIN 4

**£55**

A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, this is light, very elegant and fragile. The aromas are of white currant, white flower blossom fresh pear. The palate is at first lively, quickly settling into a creamy mousse with a perfect balance between racy fruit and soft elegance. It is long and vital to the finish.

### **COATES AND SEELY, BRUT ROSÉ NV**

WHITCHURCH, HAMPSHIRE, (12%)

BIN 5

**£55**

Very fine, lucid, pink heralds the subtle, but precise aromas of red cherry blossom, red currant and white pear. The palate is a little richer than the Brut Reserve, with more red fruit and a flash of refreshing acidity on the finish.

### **JACKIE SIMONET BLANC DE BLANCS BRUT N.V.**

FRANCE (12%) LR

BIN 6 75cl **£60**

Villers-Marmery is in the heart of the Montagne de Reims and is unusually planted to Chardonnay. Jackie Simonet is a small family owned house making precise, elegant wines using extended ageing to enhance complexity and finesse.

### **GUY FOREZ BLANC DE NOIRS 2012**

FRANCE (12%) LR

BIN 7

**£75**

Guy Forez is located in the Cotes des Bar and is produced from Pinot Noir. The 2012 vintage is one of the most exciting vintage in a decade here and this wine is carefully honed and aged before release. It is deep in colour and rich in fruit, whilst retaining true Champenois elegance.

### **BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE NV**

FRANCE (12.5%) LR

Bollinger is renowned for rich, opulent Champagne that embodies the very best that this region can produce. Notes of hazelnut, honey and biscuit overlay hints of red summer fruits.

### **BILLECART SALMON ROSÉ, BRUT NV**

FRANCE (12.5%) LR

BIN 9

**£110**

A classic wine in every sense and this has rightly become an icon of rosé wine the world over. Red fruit, a creamy mousse and a long, beautifully tapered finish demonstrate why.

## Sherries

### **BODEGAS FERNANDO CLASSIC FINO**

The cellars of Bodegas Rey Fernando de Castilla are located in the historic centre of Jerez. Bone dry, with a beautiful blend of citrus and stone fruit flavours and a wonderfully nutty finish.

### **BODEGAS HIDALGO WELLINGTON CORTADO**

JEREZ, SPAIN (18%)

The amazing thing about these old sherries is that the winery actually needs to schedule an appointment with the Consejo to unlock the barrels to bottle it! A round, plush mouthfeel of toasted nuts and caramel are enlivened by a saline note that makes this dry sherry a real treat.

### **BODEGAS FERNANDO ANTIQUE AMONTILLADO**

JEREZ, SPAIN (18%)

Glorious aromas of dried figs, cloves and orange peel, leading to a wonderfully velvety Amontillado. The Antique is just off-dry, with a hint of salty ranchio character, finishing with a very long, nutty finish that lingers and evolves for an age.

### **BODEGAS FERNANDO 'PX' ANTIQUE**

PX, or Pedro Ximinex, is the grape variety used to make this unctuous, inky super sweet wine. The long aging process and raisoned grapes create an almost resinous like texture and give flavours of nutty dried fruit, damson and Christmas cake.



## Fresh, Light White Wines

### **KARU SAUVIGNON BLANC 2017**

CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE (13%)

BIN 12

**£25**

An award winning Sauvignon Blanc, this is a perfectly balanced wine, with fresh, bright aromas of greengage and ripe apple and a crisp, mineral finish.

### **MIRABELLO PINOT GRIGIO 2017**

VENETO, ITALY (12%)

BIN 13

**£27**

From cool hillsides in Veneto, this attractive Pinot Grigio has a delicate floral and fruity bouquet. A soft, easy, dry wine that will match with a wide range of lighter dishes.

### **LAGRANJA VIURA VERDEJO '360' 2018**

RUEDA, SPAIN (12%) **LR**

BIN 14

**£29**

A delicious and bright white from a family run estate in the northern vineyards of Rueda. The blend represents the tradition of the region, and produces a bright fresh and finely aromatic, dry wine.

### **CA' ERTO SOAVE 2018**

VENETO, ITALY (12%) **LR**

BIN 15

**£32**

Ca Erto is the small house owned by Monte Tondo, a family owned estate in the famous Foscari hills in Soave. The wine is 100% Gargenega, hand-picked and fermented to ensure it is detailed, balanced and retains the delicious pineapple and floral blossom scent typical of this regions wine.

### **LAWSON'S DRY HILLS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2017**

MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND (13%) **LR**

BIN 16

**£42**

Lawson's is a family owned estate that has undergone rigorous upheaval to dramatically improve the quality of their wines. The intensity and varietal character of this wine is so typical of the region, with depth and complexity giving the wine real bite.

### **DOMAINE LABAILLE L'AUTHENTIQUE SANCERRE 2018**

LOIRE, FRANCE (12.0%) **O**

BIN 17

**£55**

Jean Paul Labaille owns vines on the chalky soils of Chavignol, home to the famous Crotin cheese and one of the regions finest vineyard areas. The wines here are taut, citric and tinged with elegant spring garden type scents.

## Fuller Bodied White Wines

### **BETOLA BIANCO 2018**

JUMILLA, SPAIN (13.5%) **LR**

BIN 18

**£29**

Betola is a blend of Chardonnay and Muscat found in the high planes of Jumilla, to the east of Valencia. It has the characters of Tangerine leaf and blossom, allied to lovely fresh fruit on the palate. Works as an aperitif as it does with food.

### **PICPOUL DE PINET, CHRISTOPHE MURET 2018**

LANGEUDOC, FRANCE (12.5%) **LR**

BIN 19

**£35**

Picpoul is fast becoming one of the 'go to' wines when fresh, sappy citrus fruit is required. This is a classic example from vines overlooking the Mediterranean, using old vines and clean, fresh winemaking.

### **JIKKEN BARERU SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018**

WESTERN CAPE SOUTH AFRICA (13.5%) **O**

BIN 20

**£35**

The Coetzee family make experimental blend of wines from their old vines located in the Cape, with this being a blend of Elgin fruit and Swartland. The expression is pure Sauvignon, but with an added complexity derived from a little ageing. It is delicious mouth-watering and an excellent food wine.

### **DOMAINE CHEVEAU MACON SOLUTRÉ-POUILLY 2018**

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (13.5%) **O**

BIN 21

**£49**

Nic Cheveau consistently makes the finest example of this wine, using old vines planted at the crest of the 'Pouilly' vineyard in the village of the same name. A rare treat, fermented in small stainless steel vats to preserve freshness and purity, the wine elegant, layered and complex and a real portal into the terroir.

### **CHATEAU DE CHEMILLY CHABLIS 2017**

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (13.5%) **O**

BIN 22

**£60**

Chemilly is one of the more southern villages of the region, and produces wines with delicious mouth-watering fruit and mineral elegance. This is fermented in stainless steel with a small portion raised in old oak to add a touch of complexity to the wine.

## Rare and Wonderful White Wines

### VINCENT CAILLÉ 'MOUTON NOIR' MUSCADET 2018

LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE (12.5%) O

BIN 24

£40

Mouton Noir is a cuvee made by Vincent to represent a new style of Muscadet, with more fruit and less lees ageing. It is delicious and refined, concentrated and long.

### ADEGAS ENTRE OS RIOS SARAS ALBARINO 2015

BARBANZA E IRIA, GALICIA (13.5%) LR

BIN 25

£50

The Albarino for this wine is from vines planted in the 19<sup>th</sup> century and come from a single, Granite, vineyard that formed part of an ancient monastic plot. The wine is fresh, infused white currant and gooseberry with lime streaks running through it.

### SWERVER SEMILLON GRIS 2018

SWARTLAND, SOUTH AFRICA (13.5%) O

BIN 24

£55

Jasper Wickens produces this wine from rarely found Semillon Gris found in his wife's vineyards on the Paaderberg. It is left on the skins for a few days prior to pressing and aging in old oak 500 litre barrels. It is rich and voluptuous, balanced by taut mineral acidity.

### ONANNON CHARDONNAY, MORNINGTON PENINSULA 2016

VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA (13.5%) LR

BIN 26

£65

Three friends founded Onannon starting with just 30 cases in 2008 from fruit grown in the cool Mornington Peninsula. Their aim is to make terroir wines with French finesse, and this Chardonnay is more than a nod to the complexity one finds in the Cote d'Or.

### PIERRE BOURET PUIGNY MONTRACHET 2013

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (13%) LR

BIN 27

£80

Pierre Bourat produces wines of real expression and purity that exude the charm of the village. This has the gentle refrain of hazelnut and almond blossom, a touch of spice and white fruit that marks the village, having been aged in French barrique for 12 months.

## Aromatic White Wines

### DOMAINE D'UBY 'NO 3' 2018

GASCONY, FRANCE (11.5%) **LR**

BIN 28

**£28**

Amazing aromatics of grapefruit, citrus zest and fresh gooseberry lead to a refreshing, vital, and light-bodied palate which both works well both with food, or as an apéritif.

### CAMILLE BRAUN EDELZWICKER 2018

ALSACE, FRANCE (12.5%) **B**

BIN 29

**£40**

A blend of Gewurztraminer Pinot Gris, Sylvaner and Riesling produced biodynamically in the vineyards of Orschwirn n Southern Alsace. It has almond blossom and rose petal aromatics and a soft a easy going palate.

### KILIKANOON MORTS BLOCK RIESLING 2015

CLARE VALLEY, AUSTRALIA (12.5 %) **LR**

BIN 30

**£45**

This Riesling is produced from three sites within the Watervale sub region of the Clare Valley. The skill here is to balance the knife edge acidity with the intense lime fruit which Kilikanoon do with consummate skill.

## Rosé Wines

### PINK CHOT ROSÉ, DOMAINE DE BASSAC 2018

LANGEUDOC, FRANCE (12.5 %) **O**

BIN 31

**£30**

Chot is the Occitan for Owl and this rose is homage to the birds that live in the vines. The wine is a Provençal style rose, fresh elegant and very refined.

### DOMAINE LOUP BLEU VOL DE NUIT 2018

CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE (13%) **LR**

BIN 32

75cl **£39**

1.5ltr **£80**

Loup Bleu is one of the leading family domains in the region producing light, delicate wines that perfectly illustrate why Provence is so famous for its rosé wines. This is a blend dominated by Grenache and Syrah with additions of Cinsault and Rolle to give extra spice and floral notes.

## Light Bodied Red Wines

### **LAGRANJA TEMPRANILLO '360' CARNINENA 2018**

CARINENA, SPAIN (12.5%) **LR**

BIN 33

**£27**

The vineyards for this family run estate are located 750 meters above sea level between Barcelona and Madrid. The wine is fresh, crunchy with classical Spanish soft spice tones and a touch of cherry fruit on the finish.

### **CARBALLAL 'CAN DO SIL' VALDEORRAS 2018**

GALICIA, SPAIN (12.5%) **LR**

BIN 34

**£31**

Can do Sil is the mountain wine one drinks when touring the Eastern reaches of Galicia. A blend of Mencia and Garnacha, it is driven by acidity rather than tannins and is super fresh and juicy.

### **DOMAINE UBY BYO CABERNET FRANC GASCONY 2018**

GASCONY, FRANCE (12.5%) **O**

BIN 35

**£40**

The vineyards of Uby are organic as a result of Francois Morels desire to protect the freshwater Turtles that live in his lake. This is an old vine Cabernet Franc that has more in common with Saumur than the simple wines typically found in the region. Bright, red fruit and cassis with a subtle hint of capsicum.

### **MANOIR DE CARRA FLEURIE 2017**

BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE (13%) **O**

BIN 36

**£50**

Manoir de Carra is a domaine run by two young sons, one a viticulturist and the other the winemaker. Both are dedicated to organic viticulture, which repays with interest in great vintages like 2014. This is elegant, floral and concentrated Fleurie at its very best.

## Medium Bodied Red Wines

### **KARU MERLOT 2016**

COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE (13%)

BIN 37

**£26**

The dry, sun-drenched climate, combined with cool nighttime temperatures, ensures perfect ripeness and good flavour retention for the Merlot grapes. Soft, plummy flavours combine with gentle tannins, giving a wine that glides easily over the palate.

## Medium Bodied Red Wines (cont.)

### **DOMAINE DE BASSAC MARGHAL ROUGE 2017**

LANGUEDOC, FRANCE (13%) **O**

BIN 38

**£28**

A local dominated by Grenache and Syrah expressing the warmth and character of the Beziers region from one of the most forward thinking growers in the mid Languedoc region. Francois Delhon is committed to organic viticulture and here produces a delicious juicy red full of cassis fruit and warm spicy characters.

### **RODRIGUEZ LAORDEN 4 ELEMENTONS CRIANZA 2016**

RIOJA, SPAIN (13%) **O**

BIN 41

**£38**

The vines are grown on the highest vineyard site in Rioja Alta and the wine is age in old American oak giving a classic poise but elegant and mineral finesse. This results in a really delicious, effortless wine which exudes the character of the vineyard. The Tempranillo Graciano and Viura blend make for a scented, confident wine with balance.

### **LE BIHAN 'AIMÉ CHAIS' COTES DU DURAS 2015**

DURAS, FRANCE (13.5%) **O**

BIN 40

**£39**

This is one of the most delicious wines you may never have heard of. A classic Merlot Petit Verdot blend more akin to St Emilion in style and taste than humble Duras, which lies just to the south west of its more famous neighbour.

### **CELLAR ALTA ALELLA 'GX' ALTA ALELLA 2018**

CATALUNYA, SPAIN (13%) **O**

BIN 41

**£40**

A tiny region just north of Barcelona where the Grenache is grown on granite vineyards overlooking the Mediterranean sea. This is juicy and fresh fermented in stainless steel to harness the mineral profile derived from the granite.

### **CLOVALLON PINOT NOIR 'LA VALLON' 2017**

BEDERIEUX, LANGUEDOC (13.5) **B**

BIN 42

**£50**

Alix Roque, trained at Domaine Roulot, has taken on the reins at Clovallon from her mother who planted this estate in 1989 on dolomitic limestone in the north of the Coteaux de Languedoc. It is pure Pinot Noir, with evolved, spicy fruit and elegant velvety texture. .

## Fuller Bodied Red Wines

### **SOLDIERS BLOCK SHIRAZ 2018**

SOUTH AUSTRALIA (13%)

BIN 43

**£26**

Soldiers Block is the archetypal Aussie Shiraz with notes of coffee and spice and deep red fruit. The wine also has some solid tannins too to bolster the southern richness.

### **NIETO MALBEC 2017**

MENDOZA, ARGENTINA (14.0%) **LR**

BIN 44

**£32**

Nieto are located in the finest vineyards for Malbec, and have etched out a reputation among the names of this region as a producer of excellent, full bodied but balanced wines. This is a brooding example spice laden wine with fully packed fruit and assertive tannins.

### **DOMAINE DE LA GRAVEIRETTE 'JU DE VIE' 2017**

RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE (14.5%) **O**

BIN 45

**£37**

Julien Mus makes this blend from vineyards around the cellar which are farmed biodynamically, and uses over 6 varieties. It is a brilliant example of how delicious and fulsome these wines can be, almost a flavour tapestry of the Chateuneuf plateau itself.

### **MASSAYA 'LE COLOMBIER' CLASSIC RED 2017**

BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON (14.5%) **LR**

BIN 46

**£45**

A name change for one of our all-time classics from the foot of Mount Lebanon. This is as alluring, spicy and rich as ever, produced from Cabernet, Syrah and Cinsault and aged in French oak barrique. The wine remains a classic and an amazing achievement given the difficult condition surrounding the vineyards.

### **PILIERES DE LA MAISON BLANCHE 2015**

MONTAGNE ST EMILION, FRANCE (13.5%) **B**

BIN 47

**£50**

The Despagne family have been converts to Biodynamic viticulture since the 60's. Charles, the current owner is one of the most talented wine makers in the region so in this wine you have a wonderful expression of the terroir through the merlot dominant blend, allied to an energy derived from the care and attention afforded the vines in their growth cycle.

## Rare and Wonderful Red Wines

### EGO BODEGAS TALENTO 2016

JUMILLA SPAIN (14%) O

BIN 48

£35

Talento is a blend of Monastrell and Syrah grown on the high planes of Jumilla south east of Madrid. It has coffee, pruneaux aromatics and a warmly spicy palate.

### TABALI TALINAY VINEYARD PINOT NOIR 2015

D.O. VALLE DEL LIMARI, CHILE (13%) LR

BIN 49

£40

Tabali have been pioneers in extreme viticulture in Chile since 2008. The Talinay vineyard has limestone 'streaks' that run through the vineyards bringing a mineral character to wines, already finessed by the high altitude of the Limari. The result is a fine, concentrated but elegant Pinot Noir.

### FABIEN JOUVES HAUT COT(E) DE FRUIT MALBEC 2018

CAHORS, FRANCE (12.5%) O

BIN 50

£40

Fabien Jouvès is one of the new great names of this region in South West France. He is born and bred Cahors, but sees a different wine to his predecessors, choosing to make wines to be drunk sooner rather than later. He is in the village of Trespoux, so at altitude and on the Quercy plateau, which gives the wines a desirable freshness and drinkability.

### SMILEY RED, SWARTLAND 'V4'

SWARTLAND, SOUTH AFRICA (13.5%) O

BIN 51

£45

Smiley red is a blend of Cinsault, Grenache Syrah and Carignan from the Swartland, a clever blend not just of varieties but of different vintages. Ryan Mostert is a rising star of the region and this wine, being rich, smooth and well honed, is part of the reason he deserves this reputation.

### CA DI MAT 'VALAUTIN' GARNCHAHA 2017

SIERRA DE GREDOS, SPAIN (14.5%) O

BIN 52

£55

Curro and Jesus are two friends who made their reputations in Ribeira Sacra (Fedellos de Couto) and have now returned to Gredos 500 metres above sea level to the west of Madrid. Here, old vine Garnacha grows in granite soil and is crafted by these two in a tiny cellar in St Martin. It is light in colour, warmly scented and seamlessly put together and finessed in old oak barrels. A real rarity.



## Rare and Wonderful Bottles

### **DOMAINE DELIANCE GIVRY 2018**

BURGUNDY, FRANCE (13.0%) **O**

BIN 53

£60

Lionel Deliance produces refined wines in the village of Dracy le Fort in the northern part of the Givry region. By using softer extraction techniques, he coaxes all the brightness and complexity out of his grapes without making them too full bodied. This is aged in old oak for 8 months and bottled for drinking fresh and young.

### **MOOROODUC ESTATE PINOT NOIR 2015**
